

What are cookies?

Our website makes use of cookies. Cookies are small text files generated when you visit our website that reside on your computer and can uniquely identify your browser. They are widely used to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

We use essential cookies that are required for the technical operation of our site. Without essential cookies our site can't operate properly.

We use performance cookies to record non-personal information regarding visitors to the site and to see how visitors move around it. This helps us to improve the way our site works by enabling us to tailor our site to the way visitors use it. The information we collect from performance cookies is aggregated which means that we cannot identify you from it. We use Google Analytics for these purposes. In this way, your visit to our web site will be logged; however, you will remain anonymous to us unless you specifically choose to share information with us. We use this information about the way in which our customers use our website to better understand which features are most popular and best meet the needs of our visitors.

Cookie	Category	Name	Purpose
User acceptance cookies	Essential	acceptcookies cookie_check_shown	Used to confirm that the website visitor has accepted the cookie policy.
CloudFlare security restrictions override cookie	Essential	__cfduid	This cookie is used to override any security restrictions based on the IP address the visitor is coming from. For example, if the visitor is in a coffee shop where there are infected machines but the visitor's machine is known and trusted the cookie can override the security setting.
CloudFlare cookie	Essential	_cf_use_ob	This is a cookie set by CloudFlare, a web service we use for caching & CDN and DNS, DDoS protection and security.

WordPress test cookies	Essential	wordpress_test_cookie	This cookie is used by WordPress to test that cookies are enabled on your browser
